

Celebrate the start of Family History Month with a trip to the Allen County Public Library Genealogy Center

The SullivanMunce Cultural Center is hosting a bus trip to the Allen County Public Library Genealogy Center in Fort Wayne, Indiana on Saturday October 2, 2010.

The Genealogy Center's collection contains over 350,000 printed volumes and 513,000 items of microfilm and microfiche. Additionally, you can access most of the major online databases free of charge while you are at the library. The Genealogy Center is considered to have the second largest genealogical research collection in the United States – only the Family History Library in Salt Lake City is larger!

Date: Saturday October 2, 2010

Time: Depart SullivanMunce Cultural Center at 6:30 am to arrive at the Genealogy Center in Fort Wayne at 9 am. Depart the Genealogy Center in Fort Wayne at 6 pm to return directly to the SullivanMunce Cultural Center. Arrive at SullivanMunce around 8:30 pm.

Cost: \$75.00

Includes round trip transportation, parking fees and bus driver gratuity. A light continental breakfast will be provided on the way to Fort Wayne. Brief tour of the Genealogy Center will be provided by a Genealogy Center staff member on arrival. Lunch is on your own.
