Looking at old Zionsville maps can be confusing. From 1852 until 1935, streets were created, named, renamed, moved, and even downgraded to alleys as the town grew and its needs changed. Remember, for decades the streets weren't even paved. Finally, in 1935, Zionsville officially renamed all of the streets in the Village. Keep this "conversion list" handy whenever reviewing old maps.
